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**10. BOARD/SUPERINTENDENT DISCUSSION**

**Reena Singh, Senior Director**, Regional Occupational Program. Career Technical Education (ROP/CTE), commented that ROP/CTE programs were in compliance with the Hancock Bill that was passed in 2006. The bill required that all ROP/CTE programs in California be sequenced from 9<sup>th</sup> grade through 12<sup>th</sup> by 2009. Mrs. Singh reported that all ROP/CTE programs must have 2 + 2 Articulation Agreements with Community Colleges as well as pursuing agreements with the Four Year Colleges. She commented that when the ROP program was established it was designed as a parallel delivery system in the high schools; therefore, when the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) conducts high school site visits, they look very closely at the Career Technical Education, career paths, emerging technology and whether the school is meeting the needs of the economic changes.
