**PROCLAIMING SEPTEMBER 15-OCTOBER 15, 2019  
AS HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH**

**September 11, 2019**

- WHEREAS,** the State of California is home to more than 14.8 million Hispanics including 3 million students of Hispanic descent, kindergarten through grade twelve, which comprises 47.6 percent of the state’s total public school student population; and
- WHEREAS,** these students reflect the great diversity of culture and heritage of the many countries of the Iberian peninsula, the continents of North and South America, and the Caribbean Islands; and
- WHEREAS,** people of Hispanic descent were an integral part both of the early exploration of the continents of North and South America, beginning with the very inception of European contact, and of the eventual European involvement in the settlement, growth, and development of California; and
- WHEREAS,** Hispanic culture and traditions are inextricably interwoven into California’s social economic fabric, and Hispanic Americans have made and continue to make important contributions in all facets of California life – government, business and industry, agriculture, trade and commerce, education, visual and performing arts, science, and sports; and
- WHEREAS,** the California State Board of Education recognizes in its Policy Statement on Multicultural Education that each student needs an opportunity to understand the common humanity underlying all people; to develop pride in his or her own identity and heritage; and to understand, respect, and accept the identity and heritage of others; and
- WHEREAS,** the *History-Social Science Framework for California Public Schools, Kindergarten Through Grade Twelve* states that the history curriculum of community, state, region, nation, and world must reflect the experiences of men and women and of different racial, religious, and ethnic groups and must be integrated at every level; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED,** that the Compton Unified School District Board of Trustees proclaims the month beginning September 15 and ending October 15, 2019 as *Hispanic Heritage Month* and encourages all district schools to commemorate this occasion with appropriate instructional activities.
